## WATER CUSTOMER INFORMATION

## **Leaks**

Leaks on the customer's side of the meter will not be adjusted, due to the Town purchasing all its' water from the Greeneville Water Commission.

## **Discontinuance of Water Service**

Accounts not paid within **10 days following the due date**, water service will be discontinued. A \$30 re-connection fee must be paid prior to re-establishing service.

## **New Service**

Customers establishing new service are assessed a non-refundable \$75 service charge to obtain water service.

## **Water Pressure**

The Town is required to maintain a minimum pressure of 20 PSI at each meter. Customers requiring more pressure than provided may choose to install a pump at their own expense.

## **Water Tap**

Water taps may be purchased for \$1200 for each ¾" connection.

### **Water Rates**

First 2,000 gallons	\$13.61 plus tax
Next 2,500 gallons	\$5.02 per 1,000 gallons plus tax
Over 4,500 gallons	\$2.97 per 1,000 gallons plus tax

All accounts with an active meter installed will be billed a minimum monthly water bill even if there is no water usage

## **Method of Payment**

Payments may be received at Town Hall, by mail, or online through [webfeepay.com](http://webfeepay.com)

We do not currently offer automatic bank draft.

## **Late Fees**

Late fees will be assessed the first working day following the due date on all active accounts not paid in full. Late fees are calculated at the rate of 10% of the current month's bill.

## **Billing**

All bills are due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. **Failure to receive your bill does not relieve the customer of penalties or cutoff.**

## **Dual Connections**

All homes must have a separate service connection (meter).

## **Cross-Connection**

Any home having an additional source of water (such as a well) other than that supplied by the Town cannot have both sources of water connected in any way.

## **Back Flow Prevention**

If the Town recognizes a potential hazard regarding the back flow of water into the public water system, a backflow prevention device will be required. Schools, greenhouses, dairy farms, beauty shops, restaurants, and sprinkler systems are examples of customers that require such a device. Please call Town Hall if you have questions.

## **Meter Reading**

All water meters are read monthly.

**Returned Check Policy**

A \$30 service charge is assessed on all returned checks.

**Source of Water**

The water is purchased from the Greeneville Water Commission and is distributed by the Town to its customers. The Town is required to perform the same testing and sampling as any other water district.
